-  Regular leash (not retractable)



Tug toy (long handled tug toys appropriately sized for your puppy's mouth)



Familiar bed or blanket to put on the ground



Treat pouch or clothing with pockets



Bowl and water



Waste bags



Car restraint (crate or harness)
