## Supplies Checklist for Socialization Away from Home

-  A hungry (not starving) puppy
-  Part of your puppy's meal
-  Great treats (diced to about ½ the size of a pencil eraser)
-  Stuffed Kong or long lasting chew
-  Plain collar, martingale collar or harness
-  Regular leash (not retractable)
-  Tug toy (long handled tug toys appropriately sized for your puppy's mouth)
-  Familiar bed or blanket to put on the ground
-  Treat pouch or clothing with pockets
-  Bowl and water
-  Waste bags
-  Car restraint (crate or harness)
-  Confidence and a plan
